GROUND'S RIDER POLICY

Horse owners and riders must observe the following conditions to make the grounds a safe place to visit:

Basic Rules

- All riders use the grounds at their own risk and must act responsibly and considerately for their own safety and that of other grounds users.
- Hard hats prefixed ASTM or SE1 or conforming to BS/EN1384, PAS015 or above with 3 attachments and the strap properly adjusted and fastened must be worn at all times when mounted.
- Correct footwear is mandatory and body protectors are strongly recommended.
- Members are required to wear Medical Armbands when riding on the grounds.
- Notices displayed on the premises are for the safety of everyone present and **MUST** be observed without exception.
- Hire course fields are roped off and out of bounds as are the farmed fields except for designated tracks, and to avoid conflicts with the cross-country track horses **MUST NOT** enter the roped-off restricted areas.
- Mount and dismount using the mounting blocks provided at all coded entrances.
- You are strongly advised not to ride alone, but if you have no choice you should inform someone of where you intend to ride and when you expect to return.
- Younger or less-experienced riders and horses should be kept under close supervision and **NOT** allowed to ride unaccompanied.
- Never ride your horse at full gallop around the grounds. This is dangerous for other grounds users as well as for you & your horse, as the land is ever-changing and there may be areas which could cause your horse to fall.
- Always carry a mobile phone and ensure you have emergency numbers logged together with the SRC grid reference **SP 155 760**.
- The main entrance postcode for SatNav location is **B93 8NB**.

All horse riding areas are secured and access is only with the code of the day which can be obtained from the office during normal hours or evenings/weekends by phone.
